INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS

A brand must be applied to livestock using the characters and location specified on the Brand Certificate. Any deviation from what is set out in the Brand Certificate is a branding error.

Reporting a branding error

When a branding error occurs, the Livestock Inspector must be notified immediately and provided with the original *Branding Error Declaration* completed by either the owner of the livestock branded in error (or the person on whose account the animals were branded) or the person making the branding error.

The Livestock Inspector will review the information on the *Branding Error Declaration* and will:

- satisfy himself/herself that the brand was applied in error,
- determine if an inspection of the livestock is required,
- determine if a *Brand Release* form from the registered owner of the brand applied in error is required,
- complete Part D and the top portion of the *Branding Error Declaration Inspection Form*,
- forward the original of pages 1 and 2 of the *Branding Error Declaration* (Parts A, B, C and D) and a copy of the *Branding Error Declaration Inspection Form* to the LIS Head Office so notice of the branding error can be entered into the LIS database to alert all Livestock Inspectors of the branding error, and
- provide the person completing the *Branding Error Declaration* with a copy of pages 1 and 2 (Parts A, B, C and D) and the original *Branding Error Declaration Inspection Form*.

Depending on the nature of the branding error and the number of head involved LIS may require the livestock branded in error to be inspected. If a livestock inspection is required the owner of the livestock is responsible for the costs of the inspection and will be invoiced by LIS as per LIS policies in place at the time of the inspection.

If a branding error is not reported until the livestock is inspected the Livestock Inspector will either hold the livestock or hold the sale proceeds until the Livestock Inspector is satisfied that the person in possession of the livestock is the owner of the livestock or the owner's agent; that the livestock was branded in error; and, if the error is a registered brand, that the owner of the brand has signed a *Brand Release*. An unreported branding error will hold up a sale of livestock, the issuance of a livestock permit or a special permit.

Requirements on inspection for a permit or at an inspection site

The *Branding Error Declaration Inspection Form* must be presented to the Livestock Inspector each time livestock branded in error is inspected (whether at an inspection site, for the issuance of a permit, or as a result of a requested inspection).

The Livestock Inspector will complete one row on the bottom half of the *Branding Error Declaration Inspection Form* only when the livestock enter an inspection site for the purpose of sale. After each

inspection, the *Branding Error Declaration Inspection Form* will be returned to the producer until all of the livestock branded in error have been sold.

Once all the livestock branded in error have been sold and the last entry has been made by the Livestock Inspector, the Livestock Inspector will:

- keep the original *Branding Error Declaration Inspection Form* and, on request, provide a copy to the owner of the livestock, and
- forward the original *Branding Error Declaration Inspection Form* to the LIS head office to remove the branding error notice from the LIS database.
